



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
EAST KALIMANTAN REGIONAL RESEARCH AND INNOVATION AGENCY (BRIDA KALTIM)
AND
INSTITUTION FOR MARINE AND ISLAND CULTURES, MOKPO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
ON COOPERATION IN ACADEMIC, RESEARCH AND COMMUNITY SERVICE**

On Tuesday 22nd August 2023, we are undersigned:

- I. Dr. M. Ir. Fitriansyah, ST, MM. : Head of East Kalimantan Regional Research and Innovation Agency (BRIDA KALTIM), addressed at MT. Haryono 126 Samarinda, East Kalimantan, Republic of Indonesia. In this case acting for and on behalf of the Regional Government of East Kalimantan Province, here in after referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**.
- II. Prof. Seok-Joon Hong, Ph.D. : Director of Institution for Marine and Island Culture, Mokpo National University, Republic of Korea, addressed at Songrim-ro 41-11, Mokpo, Republic of Korea, here in after referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**.

The **FIRST PARTY** and the **SECOND PARTY** hereinafter together in this Memorandum of Understanding are called **THE PARTIES**, and individually they are called **PARTY**. The **PARTIES** must first explain the following:

- I. The **FIRST PARTY** is an institution that administers the governmental affairs of the Province of East Kalimantan in accordance with the principles of autonomy and co-administration, as well as the principles of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia as referred to in the Republic of Indonesia's 1945 Constitution.
- II. The **SECOND PARTY** is Mokpo National University of South Korea which oversees coordinating academic instruction to increase human resources in the country.

- III. Given the importance of partnership between the East Kalimantan Provincial Government and Mokpo National University of South Korea in education, research, and community service.

Based on these matters, in accordance with their respective positions, the **PARTIES** agreed to implement the Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in Education, Training, and Community Service, with the terms and conditions as follows:

ARTICLE 1 PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- 1) The purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding is to improve the quality of Human Resources in East Kalimantan, Indonesia.
- 2) The objective of the Memorandum of Understanding is to support development in the Province of East Kalimantan Indonesia, which covers the entire territory of the regency or city government, to generate benefits for both parties.
- 3) Through this agreement, mutual cooperation in research and education related to islands and regional issues between Institution for Marine and Island Cultures, South Korea and East Kalimantan Regional Research and Innovation Agency, Indonesia will be strengthened.

ARTICLE 2 OBJECT OF THE MUTUAL AGREEMENT

- 1) Education;
- 2) Research;
- 3) Community Service;
- 4) Technology and Innovation; and
- 5) Other fields considered necessary.

ARTICLE 3 SCOPE AND LIMITATION

The **PARTIES** agree to cooperate with the scope covering aspects of teaching and education, guidance, assistance, formulation of scientific thinking, planning, implementation, supervision, maintenance, and evaluation related to resources in developing East Kalimantan Province.

ARTICLE 4 IMPLEMENTATION

- 1) This Memorandum of Understanding will be followed up in the form of a Cooperation Agreement that regulates rights and responsibilities, task mechanisms, and other necessary matters.
- 2) For the discussion and implementation of the Cooperation Agreement as referred to in paragraph (1) above, the **FIRST PARTY** agrees to give authority to Regional Apparatuses that have duties and functions in accordance with the field being cooperated with.
- 3) For the signing of the Cooperation Agreement, the **FIRST PARTY** agrees to give authority to the Head of Regional apparatuses, who have duties and functions in accordance with the field being cooperated in. The **SECOND PARTY** agreed to be represented by the Chancellor and the Lecturers in accordance with the field of work being collaborated on.

ARTICLE 5 RESOURCES

To support this cooperation program, the **SECOND PARTY** aids in the form of human resources that have the expertise needed by the **FIRST PARTY**, both in the form of groups and individuals for and/or in a unitary activity, while the **FIRST PARTY** provides adequate facilities based on Memorandum of Understanding and all costs incurred arising because of the implementation of these activities will be discussed together and set forth in the Cooperation Agreement.

ARTICLE 6 TIME PERIOD

This Memorandum of Understanding is valid for a period of 3 (three) years from the date it is signed, with the provisions that every 6 (six) months an evaluation can be carried out and the period can be extended if the **PARTIES** agree.

ARTICLE 7 CORRESPONDENCE

Any notification or other communication required in connection with this Mutual Agreement and other activities that will be carried out or submitted by each **PARTY** to the other **PARTIES** shall be made in writing to the address of each **PARTY** as follows:

ARTICLE 8

CLOSING

Matters that have not been sufficiently regulated in this Memorandum of Understanding if they do not conflict with the intent and content will be further regulated by the **PARTIES** based on the Collective Agreement set forth in the form of an Additional Memorandum of Understanding (Addendum) as an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Thus, this Memorandum of Understanding was drawn up and signed in Mokpo on the day and date specified in two (two) copies sufficiently stamped. each having the same legal force.
